
## WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY

Every year, millions of people around the globe become victims of human trafficking. It is one of the most pressing human rights issues of our time. This World Day is observed to raise awareness, encourage action, and promote the protection of victims. Since 2021, New Zealand has been ranked Tier 2 in the U.S. Department of State's Trafficking in Persons (TIP) Report—a downgrade from its previous Tier 1 status held since 2004. This ranking means New Zealand's efforts to meet the minimum standards for eliminating trafficking are declining.
